

The Miss Chapel Hill Pageants 2018

The Miss Chapel Hill pageants will be on **Friday, May 4th** and **Saturday, May 5th** in the Forrest High School Auditorium. The Miss Chapel Hill pageants are for girls' ages 0 months to 12th grade. The pageant entry fee is \$40.00 and \$30.00 for each additional sibling. **Each participant that registers by April 13th, will receive a pageant t-shirt with their name and division on the back.** The price of the t-shirt is included in the registration cost. Extra t-shirts can be purchased; \$10 for youth sizes and \$12 for adult sizes. This will need to be indicated on the application and paid for by the deadline on **April 13th**. Submit a recent 4x6 picture for the judge's book. Please put your child's name and division on the back of the picture. Pageant forms, picture, and money must be turned in to Mrs. Burkett at CHES or the offices at both DHIS and FHS by Friday, April 13th to receive a t-shirt. Please send all money in a sealed envelope labeled Miss CH Pageants along with the participants name and the amount enclosed. Make checks payable to CHTA. **We will be taking applications until Friday, April 20th; however, you will not receive a t-shirt.**

Practice for Baby, Tiny, and Petite will be Monday, April 30th at 5:00. Princess, Little, and Junior will practice Tuesday, May 1st at 5:00. Teen will practice Wednesday, May 2nd after school until 5:00. Miss will practice Thursday, May 3rd after school until 5:00. All practices will be held in the FHS Auditorium. You will receive your pageant number on the night of practice. People's Choice boxes need to be turned in on the night of your practice.

The categories and times are as follows:

Friday, May 4th: Teen and Miss Pageants will be \$10.00 at the door. No tickets will be sold before. You will be able to watch both pageants.

Teen Miss: 7th-8th Grade at 6:00p.m.

Miss: 9th-12th Grade—The Miss pageant will start immediately following the Teen pageant.

Saturday, May 5th: Admission for the pageants listed below is \$5.00 per pageant.

Baby Miss: 0-18 months at 8:00a.m.

Tiny Miss: 19-36 months at 8:30a.m.

Petite Miss: 37 months-5 years (NOT IN KG) at 9:00a.m.

Princess Miss: Kindergarten-1st Grade at 10:00a.m.

Little Miss: 2nd-3rd Grade at 11:30p.m.

Junior Miss: 4th-6th Grade at 1:00p.m.

People's Choice: This category is based on the contestants with the highest donations from the audience the day of the pageant. NOTE: No donation will be turned away, however, money has to be counted the day of the pageant, so loose coins will not be counted towards the contestant's total. Cash and checks (made payable to CHTA) will be counted towards the contestant's total. CONTESTANTS THAT PARTICIPATE IN PEOPLE'S CHOICE ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE A PERSONALLY DECORATED BOX (no larger than a man's shoe box.) On your box please have a picture along with the contestants name. Winners of this division will still be eligible to win their age division crowns as well. This competition has no bearing on the outcome of the overall pageant! Winners will receive a People's Choice Winner sash. Bring your People's Choice box to practice with you to practice. We will set out all boxes on Friday night.

0 months-6th grade contestants will wear a pageant dress. Teen Contestants will wear a casual outfit and a short pageant dress. **Please do not wear a long dress if you are in the Teen pageant.** Miss Chapel Hill contestants will wear a casual outfit and a formal pageant dress.

Please feel free to email with any questions you may have before practice. Remember the pageants are a fundraiser for the FHS Cheerleading Squad and are ultimately about having fun.
